Mop your floors with vinegar and hot water once a month to add shine. Use 1 cup (240 ml) of vinegar per 1 gallon (3.8 l) of water. Dip your microfiber mop in the vinegar and water mixture, then move it back and forth across your floors. Only use this method once a month or less to prevent damage to the protective seal on the laminate.
