When using CBM, the instructor gives the student brief, timed samples, or "probes," made up of academic material taken from the child's school curriculum.

### Evidence Based Practice Manual

The assessments on easyCBM are curriculum-based measures, or CBMs, which are standardized measures that sample from a year's worth of curriculum to assess the degree to which students have mastered the skills and knowledge deemed critical at each grade level. They are also known as 'general outcome measures'.

Curriculum-based measurement (CBM) is a set of methods used to index academic competence and progress (Fuchs & Fuchs, 2002). CBM is designed to be an efficient, reliable, and valid assessment of academic performance. Each assessment samples a relatively broad range of skills by sampling from each dimension of the annual curriculum.

### Curriculum-Based Measurement

Curriculum-based measurement in reading (CBM-R) and the Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) are assessment tools widely employed for universal screening in schools. Although a large body of research supports the validity of CBM-R, limited empirical evidence exists supporting the technical adequacy of MAP or the acceptability of either measure for universal screening.
