The best known of the FIDIC contracts are the Red Book (building and engineering works designed by the Employer) and the Yellow Book (M&E, building and engineering works designed by the Contractor). The original edition of the Red Book dates back to 1957. In recent years FIDIC has published many new contracts to complement the suite.

Whilst this judgment provides useful guidance (and highlights some of the difficulties) in respect of the relationship between Sub-Clause 2.5 and Sub-Clause 8.7, it is important to remember that Sub-Clause 8.7 had been amended from the standard form of FIDIC Yellow Book and the same conclusions cannot be drawn in respect of every contract.
