For example, in 2011, while the median health care expenditure for this group was \$2,814, the mean was much higher at \$6,603. The two components of household expenditures that show a declining pattern across age groups are transportation expenses and entertainment expenses. As a share of total expenses, transportation expenses fall the most.
