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Major Trauma Clinical Guidelines

This guideline provides guidance on the assessment and management of major trauma, including resuscitation following major blood loss associated with trauma. For the purposes of this guideline, major trauma is defined as an injury or a combination of injuries that are life-threatening and could be life changing because it may result in long-term disability.

In the absence of an internationally recognised standard definition of major trauma, Victoria applies the following operational definition of major trauma in injured patients: Death after injury. Admission to an intensive care unit for more than 24 hours, requiring a period of mechanical ventilation. Serious injury to two or more body systems.

Clinical Practice Guidelines : Burns - Acute Management

A Hospital Major Trauma Service has responsibility and governance for all Major Trauma Care in Hospital. The Major Trauma Centre will provide a dedicated Major Trauma Service for patients of Major Trauma which consists of the following: A dedicated trauma ward. A designated consultant available 24/7 who has responsibility for the Major Trauma Service and leads the multidisciplinary care team.

v1.0 The Clinical Guidelines for use in a Major Incident have been created with the occasional trauma team in mind, for example, for surgeons in a trauma unit who need to treat a deteriorating P2 patient, or a P1 patient who has been conveyed to the trauma unit, during a major incident response.

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
