General Surgery and Orthopaedic Surgery candidates based in New Zealand will be allocated to the Auckland exam while candidates based in Australia will be allocated to the Melbourne exam.

As stated in the Rules and Procedures, candidates for Board Certification by the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery (ABOS) are required to complete an orthopaedic residency education program that is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME).

Part I | ABOS

Candidates for the fellowship examination in Paediatric Orthopaedic Surgery should normally have passed the Orthopaedic fellowship examination of this College and possess the qualification FCS(ECSA). 3.4. Exemption to the requirement of possessing the FCS(ECSA) qualification may be given to those who have passed an equivalent examination.

Candidates may apply to only one program at a time. You may apply to the same program at more than one campus, if available. Candidates for the fellowship examination in orthopaedic surgery should normally have passed the membership examination of this College and possess the qualification MCS(ECSA). 3.4. Candidates are required to have spent three years in supervised COSECSA accredited training posts.

Regulations and Syllabus relating to Fellowship ...

Any unsuccessful candidate can challenge a specific question following the exam by contacting the test vendor in writing. Challenges to any question should be made no later than 6 months after the examination date. Candidates will not be given an opportunity to view any specific items after the examination has been completed.

This may be in the fifth year of training if the candidate is projected to be training complete at the end of the fifth year. 2.
