Wallpaper Repair Tips

No matter where the loose seam is or what caused it, the repair procedure is the same: Dip a small artist's brush into wallpaper-seam adhesive (about \$3 for a 4-oz. tube at paint and wallcovering stores). Spread an even coat of adhesive onto the underside of the exposed seam (photo 1). Then use a wooden seam roller to flatten the seam (photo 2).

1Apply new adhesive. Moisten the peeling or damaged portion of the seam. Then carefully lift up the loose section of wallpaper and, using a small brush, apply a thin, even coating of wallpaper glue or adhesive to the underside of the piece you wish to reattach. 2 Reseat the wallpaper seam.

Place the pointed nozzle of the seam adhesive under the loose edge, seam, or tear and squeeze enough adhesive to coat the torn area. Don't apply so much that it get drippy. Let the adhesive dry for 15 minutes. Some new products dry solid within a few minutes, so be sure to follow the manufacturer's directions.

A. Use a roll to lay out the wall Use a full roll of paper as a guide to lay out the room. Butt a roll into the corner where you plan to start, and make a pencil mark on the wall at the edge of the roll. Slide the roll down to that mark, and make another pencil mark at the other edge of the roll.

Once you have put the patch in, you can use vinyl wallpaper to cover it so your RV looks just like new. A white latex thinned by water should be the right adhesive to use to secure the vinyl wallpaper. To hide the seams, just wrap the trim in the same material and adhesive. Wait until it dries then use a staple gun to attach it to your wall.

Replacing RV Wall Paneling in 10 Steps (RV Wall Repair Tips)

Clean up loose corners and edges. If your wallpaper is as old as mine, you're bound to find a corner here or a seam there that isn't adhered as well as it should be. This shouldn't be enough to deter you entirely, but should be handled carefully. I recommend using a strong adhesive to re-affix those pesky corners.
